BULK ITEM COLLECTION

*The Public Service Department has streamlined the bulk item collection process and pricing. Residents can continue to put out various bulk items for collection by solid waste crews, as long as the appropriate number of Solid Waste stickers (currently \$2.90 per sticker) have been affixed to each item.
Place items at the curb by 7 a.m. on your regular collection day.*

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Require 3 Stickers

Small Appliances

- Air conditioners (*window units**)
- Humidifiers/dehumidifiers*
- Microwaves/toasters

Other

- Bicycles

Small Furniture

- Headboards
- Chairs (*not stuffed*)
- Carpets (*up to 5 ft*)
- Wood pallets
- Small tables (*up to 4 ft*)

Construction Debris

- Metal awning/railings
- Bath tubs
- Shower stalls
- Sinks/toilets/pipes
- Cabinets (*metal/wood*)
- Counter tops

Require 5 Stickers

Large Appliances

- Ovens/rangetops/stoves
- Refrigerators/freezers*
- Stoves/ovens
- Washers/dryers
- Water heaters/water softeners
- Dishwashers

Large Furniture

- Sofas/loveseats
- Mattresses/box springs
- Bathroom vanities
- Drawers/hutches
- Large table (*over 4 ft*)
- Picnic/ping-pong tables

NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS

Car Parts

- Tires/rims
- Bumpers/fenders
- Doors/hoods

e-Waste

- Televisions
- Computer monitors/towers
- Printers

Other

- Tractors/mowers
- Household hazardous waste

SPECIAL HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS

- * Items containing freon are not accepted curbside. Call an appliance store to have the Freon removed.
- † Propane tanks are not accepted curbside.

This list provides examples of commonly collected items.
